



DIVISION CHAMPION POLICY for KOHL'S CUP

A. TEAM DIVISIONS

All division champions U10 and above are eligible to represent Marion County in the State Kohl's Cup tournament.

B. DIVISION CHAMPION DETERMINATION

Division champions will be determined by the Board of Directors based on Regular Season Play. First place teams in each division above U10 will be awarded paid entry into the tournament. Additional expenses are not paid. If 1st place declines, the 2nd place team becomes eligible for the award etc... Team's registration will be handled by the registrar. MCYSA Champion representative for Kohl's Cup will be determined as follows:

- Divisions with 3 teams or less must have played a complete double round robin.
- Divisions with 4 or more teams must have played a complete round robin.
- The team that earns the paid Kohl's Cup entry is determined based on which team earns the most points during their division's round robin play.
- Teams earn 3 points for a win, 1 point for a draw, and 0 point for a loss. If the point totals end in a 2-way tie, the first tie breaker is head to head result. If that result was a draw, the second tie breaker is goal differential with a per game max differential of plus or minus 3.
- If the points end with 3 or more teams tied, the first tie breaker is goal differential with a per game max differential of plus or minus 3 and the second tie breaker is head to head result.
- In both cases, if those tie breaker criteria do not determine a winning team, a playoff game will be scheduled to determine who is awarded the paid entry fee.

C. COORDINATOR GUIDELINES

Division coordinators please note that selection for Kohl's Cup must take place in early October so please ensure these round robin events are completed before that time period when scheduling.
